In some countries, different regulations apply to the flying of flags. In the UK flags can be flown at any time of day, and at night if illuminated, which does not apply to use indoors. They are otherwise specifically exempt from planning rules.

Most flags are designed for a 3:2 aspect ratio, with some notable restrictions, such as Switzerland which specifies a square (1:1) design, and the likes of Nepal, which is just plain odd, but luckily not in Euro 2024. A4 paper (and all A-series sizes) are  $\sqrt{2}:1$  (1.4142 : 1) which is close enough for most purposes.
